

# International Day for Biological Diversity (IDB)- 2022

22<sup>nd</sup> May 2022

## Theme- “Building a shared future for all life”

Goa State Biodiversity Board (GSBB) is conducting following competitions on occasion of IDB- 2022.

1. Authentic Goan Traditional Recipes
2. Short Film Making Competition
3. Abstract and Poster Presentation

Rules and Criteria is given below

### **1. Authentic Goan Traditional Recipes**

Competition in two different categories as per One District One Product (ODOP):

- 1) Jackfruit
- 2) Coconut

Prize:

1. First Prize- ₹ 10,000
2. Second Prize- ₹ 7,500
3. Third Prize- ₹ 5,000

Rules and Criteria for the Competition:

1. **Main ingredient of the recipe should be one of the ODOP resource.**
2. Pre-registration mandatory. **Registration Should be done before 25.05.2022.**
3. Dish should be authentic to Goa.
4. Item should specify Ingredients, recipe, Method & whether veg or non- veg.
5. The participant selected based on entry will have to bring at desired venue of GSBB.
6. The intimation will be given to participants 3 days in advance.
7. Quantity of dish should be minimum 750gm/750ml or 1 Kg
8. Presentation of dish should be in eco-friendly vessel only.
9. Maximum local ingredients should be used.
10. All the entries should be endorsed by Local BMCs.
11. Decision of GSBB jury would be final and binding.

## **2. Short Film Making Competition**

### Prize:

4. First Prize- ₹ 10,000
5. Second Prize- ₹ 7,500
6. Third Prize- ₹ 5,000

### Themes:

1. People's Biodiversity Register
2. Traditional practices associated with biodiversity and environment
3. Biodiversity and climate change.
4. Dynamic seashores.

### Rules and Criteria for the Competition:

1. Registration is free for all participants
2. Time duration- 4-5 minutes.
3. The short film shall be submitted on the following mail: [goanbiodiversity@gmail.com](mailto:goanbiodiversity@gmail.com).  
The acknowledgement of the receipt of the short film will be sent via an email within three working days.
4. Old video clips shot by participants can be added into the film.
5. Film's theme should fall under the mentioned categories.
6. Film should be submitted in 1080 MP4 or equivalent format.
7. Label the short film file name as 'Participant's Name-Short Film Title-Language'.
8. A brief description (50-100) words should be provided in the email along with the short film.
9. Language of the film allowed are - Silent/ English/ Hindi/ Marathi/ Konkani.
10. Political or Racist videos are not allowed
11. Vulgarity and obscenity will strictly not be tolerated.
12. Competition is only open to college students and research scholars from any stream, in the age group of 18-25 years. An ID for age proof needs to be provided in the email.
13. Only one entry by one participant is allowed.
14. Work should be original. No copyrighted content is allowed.
15. Last Date to submit entry is 26.05.2022
16. Decision of GSBB jury would be final and binding.

### **3. Abstract and Poster Presentation**

#### Prize:

1. First Prize- ₹ 7,500
2. Second Prize- ₹ 5,000
3. Third Prize- ₹ 2,500

#### Themes:

1. Sand dunes ecosystem.
2. Prevention & spread of zoonotic diseases.
3. Impacts of tourism on coastal ecosystem.
4. Urban biodiversity (specific to Goa).
5. Impact of climate change on coastal ecosystem.
6. Goa's unique biodiversity/ ecosystems/ associated traditional practices.

#### Rules and Guidelines:

1. The abstract shall be submitted on the following mail: [goanbiodiversity@gmail.com](mailto:goanbiodiversity@gmail.com). The acknowledgement of the receipt of the abstract will be sent via an email within three working days.
2. The abstract should be submitted in the format of MS Word (.doc or .docx) document titled as "First Author Surname Initials – Abstract - Title of manuscript".
3. The first author should be same as presenting author.
4. Presenting author's contact details to be mentioned in the email body sent along with the abstract (The contact details should be the same details as the submitting author so that the presenting author receives the correspondence about the abstract)
  - a. Email address
  - b. Full postal address
  - c. Phone number
5. The abstracts should be broadly falling under the mentioned themes.
6. Abstracts should be representing the original work of the author/s.
7. The Abstract should be written in English.
8. Abstract received after the given deadline, due to any reason will not be accepted unless the deadline is extended.
9. Only college going students, recent graduates and research scholars in the age group of 18-30 years, are allowed to participate in the competition.
10. Abstracts previously presented will not be accepted.
11. The poster is recommended to be of size 48 inches' width and 36 inches' height and should have good quality print.

12. Last Date to submit abstract is **23.05.2022**. On successful acceptance of the abstract the participant will be required to prepare a poster. The decision regarding acceptance of the abstract would be communicated **3 days after the deadline**.
13. Decision of GSBB jury would be final and binding.

Guidelines for Abstract Structure:

1. Abstract title - Please choose a brief title (maximum of 100 characters/ 20 words) that clearly indicates the content of the contribution. Please avoid abbreviations in the title. Abbreviations may be used in the text if they are defined when first used.
  2. Abstract text – limited to 300 words. Please ensure that the abstract does not contain spelling, grammar or scientific notation errors. The abstract should not include tables, graphs and images.
  3. Abstract layout - Abstracts must be submitted with the following sections:
    - a. Objectives
    - b. Methods
    - c. Results
    - d. Conclusions
  4. A separate image file (only one page) containing the most relevant graphs, table and image may be submitted in jpeg/ jpg format. The maximum file size of each image is 500 KB.
  5. Key-words: Please indicate 3-5 keywords for your abstract.
  6. Mention the names of authors along with their designation, department and email address in the ‘footer’ section of the submitted abstract.
  7. References are not obligatory and word count is affected by inclusion of references.
  8. Title should be in Times New Roman font, size 14 pt., and bold; it should be centred across the page. Rest all text should be in Times New Roman font, size 12 pt.
