### Report of Goa State Biodiversity Conservation Awards – 2020



The Government of Goa's "Goa State Biodiversity Conservation Awards-2020" in appreciation of exemplary contribution in the field of conservation of biodiversity, ecology and environment were presented at an awards presentation ceremony held on 02<sup>nd</sup> October 2020 at Conference hall, Goa State Biodiversity Board (GSBB), Saligao, Goa.

The dignitaries present included the Chief Guest, Shri. Kunal, IAS, Secretary Environment, Government of Goa; Shri Subhash Chandra, IFS, Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (PCCF), Government of Goa, and Shri. In individual category, Shri. Suryakant Shankar Gaonkar, from North Goa & Shri. Janu Ghurkho Gaonkar, from South Goa were awarded the State Biodiversity Award for their contributions in the field of Biodiversity & Environment. Both the Awardees were felicitated at the hands of Chief Guest Shri. Kunal, IAS, Secretary Environment and Shri Subhash Chandra, IFS, PCCF, with Shawl and Shriphal, Memento, Citation and a sum of Rupees Twenty-Five thousand each.

Shri. Suryakant Shankar Gaonkar has been awarded for involvement in biodiversity conservation activities, excellent biodiversity documentation. He has produced natural colours and is educating and advocating its use during holi instead of chemical colours. He is actively involved in PBR preparation of his own and neighboring villages. He has been felicitated by different organizations for his selfless service, and ecofriendly decorations, organizing educational activities for students and adults on environment and biodiversity.

Shri. Janu Ghurko Gaonkar from South Goa has been awarded for his service as Traditional Medicinal Practitioner with vast experience and selfless service in his tribal village and adjoining villages, Excellent traditional knowledge of flora & fauna. He is a much sought after traditional medicinal practitioner- 'Voktoli' for his guaranteed cures to a number of ailments. However, he does not charge monetary fees and subsists on whatever fees are voluntarily given and working as a farm labourer or any other menial work. He even has knowledge of gynaecologic ailments of women and has helped in difficult childbirth in very inaccessible and remote tribal areas of Khotigao, Canacona.
