The Village Panchayat Ambaulim inaugurated its Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) on 28th June 2016, at 11:00 am in the presence of Smt. Fatima Rocha, Sarpanch, Ambaulim Panchayat; Dr. Mahendra Bale, Veterinary Doctor and Staff of Goa State Biodiversity Board.

Smt. Fatima Rocha extended a floral welcome to the dignitaries and addressed the gathering. This was followed by lighting of the traditional lamp by the dignitaries.

Smt. Reshma Kerkar, Scientific Officer Goa State Biodiversity Board explained the importance of the Biodiversity Management Committee as well as the need to protect and preserve the rich biodiversity of the village.
